CONCENTRATED DISHMACHINE DRYING AND RINSE AID

GENERAL INFORMATION

This product is an excellent drying aid for use in low temperature mechanical warewash operations. When dispensed through any type of commonly used rinse additive dispenser, it provides a positive aid to kitchen sanitation. It is safe to use on plastic, china and silverware, and will eliminate unsightly water spotting. This product works especially well in machines with rinse water temps that are unusually cold, and thus will not create excessive foam.



DIRECTIONS

READ LABEL AND MSDS PRIOR TO USE

1. Pre-flush and /or scrape dishes before washing.
2. Rack dishes properly. Place dishes in machine with space between utensils.
3. Wash using CHEM TECH'S PREMIUM DETERGENT or equivalent warewash detergent. Concentration will vary due to environmental conditions. Maintain 140-160°F wash temperature (High temp machines require higher temp. settings).
4. For rinse cycle, use this product. Be sure rinse injector is working properly.
5. For LOW TEMP MACHINES: after rinse cycle sanitize using chlorine sanitizer with at least 50 ppm (confirm concentration with test kit).
6. For HIGH TEMP MACHINES: maintain at least 175°F for at least 15 seconds during the rinse cycle.
7. Allow dishes to air dry. Do not use towel.

FIRST AID

INGESTION: Do not induce vomiting. If patient is conscious and can swallow, administer milk or water.

EYES: Flood with lukewarm (not hot) water poured from a large glass 2 or 3 inches from eyes. Remove contacts. Continue flooding for 15 minutes.

INHALATION: Not a hazard.

ADMINISTER FIRST AID AND TREATMENT AS STATED ABOVE THEN CONTACT A PHYSICIAN.
